Housing renewals for the next academic year will occur in mid-Spring. I understand that a fall-only contract is not available. Should I decide to leave UCCS prior to the end of the term, I will complete a withdrawal form on the housing website, and I understand that my deposit will be forfeited.

Personal Responsibility: I understand that I am taking full personal responsibility and will be held to the UCCS Code of Conduct, the Residence Life Handbook, and the Housing Contract; these documents can be found by clicking [here](#). Furthermore, I take full financial responsibility for prompt payment through my student portal for housing charges. Rates for all room types can be found by clicking [here](#).

Priority date: I understand that the housing application priority date is March 15th. This date is not a deadline, but students who apply by this date will have a greater chance of being assigned to their preferences of theme floor, room type, and roommates. I also understand that regardless of application submission date, no guarantees can be made in regards to room assignment. The first round of room assignment notifications will be sent to your UCCS email in early May, and then at least monthly during the summer.

Residence Life and Housing Contract

GENERAL

This Contract is between the Student/Applicant named at the end of this agreement ("Student") and the Regents of the University of Colorado, a body corporate, for and on behalf of the University of Colorado - Colorado Springs ("University") regarding the terms and conditions of occupancy. NOTE: This Contract is for room, board, and parking in the University's Residence Hall Facilities or room and parking only in the Apartment Facilities (collectively "Housing Facilities") for the academic year listed above. The University's Office of Residence Life and Housing ("Housing") will assign the Student to housing in its Housing Facilities, and the Student is then entitled to use the Housing Facilities in accordance with the terms and conditions outlined below. The Student must also comply with all University policies, and federal, state, and local laws. This Contract may not be assigned to another party, and it is agreed and understood that this Contract is incorporated by reference into the Housing Application. There may be times when the contract needs to be updated during the contract term to reflect non-substantive changes in policy and procedure. If this occurs, the Student will be notified in writing of the specific change a minimum of two weeks prior to the change taking effect.

EFFECTIVE DATE OF CONTRACT PERIOD

This Contract becomes effective upon the Student's submission of a Housing Application ("Application") and shall remain in effect for the current academic year.

EXPLORING NURSING RLC

(La Plata House, 2nd Floor)

Interested in the Nursing field? Whether you are majoring in Nursing, a prospective Nursing student, or exploring the Nursing field, the Exploring Nursing Residential Learning Community (RLC) is for you! As a member of this RLC, you'll be required to take a common first-year course together, explore nursing-related programs/topics, participate in nursing-related activities, and live together as neighbors on the same floor. In the Spring semester, you will continue building academic and social community with fellow Exploring Nursing students. Open to first-year students living on campus for Fall 2024. You will participate as a cohort where you will:

- Connect to UCCS and live on the same floor in housing
- Develop a strong sense of citizenship, community, and purpose
- Participate in co-curricular experiences in your area of interest and beyond
- Take Gateway Program Seminar (GPS) Pathways: **Exploring Nursing**
- Continuing academic community with your fellow RLC students

Requirements: To participate in the Exploring Nursing RLC, students must take the assigned GPS course that is focused on nursing exploration (and offered in Fall 2024) **AND** live on the designated floor in on-campus housing. If you apply by March 1st, the RLC will be your priority placement for housing. If you have a roommate preference, they must also be participating in this RLC. Room type preference will be based on availability.

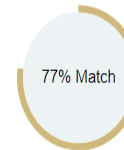

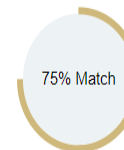


